The Pre-Pharmacy Advantage Program gives first-time freshmen the opportunity to complete their undergraduate requirements in the same environment as their professional doctor of pharmacy (PharmD) studies. Our pre-pharmacy program lays a strong foundation, setting you up for success as you pursue a career in pharmacy.

Guaranteed PharmD admission. Pacific offers three freshman admission pathways for completing the Pre-Pharmacy Advantage Program. Each pathway requires a minimum overall 3.0 GPA and a 2.7 GPA in specific math and science courses, in addition to submission of an advancement application, an interview and a writing sample. Completion of these requirements guarantees admission into our PharmD program.

Access to faculty and current students. Our Pre-Pharmacy Advantage Program brings current PharmD and pre-pharmacy students together. As a pre-pharmacy student, you are a member of the student body. This means that as a pre-pharmacy student you will have access to many of the same opportunities, resources and support systems available to our professional students.

The development of a future pharmacist begins in the first semester of undergraduate education. Being true to this, our pre-pharmacy program curriculum and its academic requirements put top priority on student success. To facilitate your development and success in the program, you will be assigned a pharmacy faculty member as your academic advisor. They will help you navigate your course load, plan each academic semester and support you every step of the way.

Plenty of opportunities to get involved. Choose from over 150 student organizations. Enjoy some friendly competition by joining an intramural or club team — we have everything from volleyball to rowing. Rush a fraternity or sorority. Pathways

Earn your PharmD in as few as five years. You could be enrolled in one of three pathways, completing your PharmD in five, six or seven years.

Five-year (2+3)

Two years of undergraduate study followed by three years of study in the professional PharmD program.

Six-year (3+3)

Three years of undergraduate study followed by three years of study in the professional PharmD program.

Seven-year (4+3)

Four years of undergraduate study, earning a bachelor's degree, followed by three years of study in the professional PharmD program.
